Due To Popular Demand, Witte Extends Dinosaur Exhibit Now on View Through January 1, 2008

SAN ANTONIO—With attendance numbers hitting **100,000** visitors during the first two months of *Return of the Dinosaurs: Extreme Makeover*, and with more than 257,000 visitors this fiscal year, the Witte Museum has decided to keep the dinosaurs out of extinction through **January 1, 2008**.

Walk amongst a Stegosaurus, Triceratops or even a baby T-Rex and discover the dinosaurs that roamed the land millions of years ago. Get a closer look at these Cretaceous creatures through robotic technology, interpretive panels, interactive displays and dioramas highlighting scientific information and discoveries. Burrow down and examine fossils in a paleontological dig or choose from a variety of dinosaur body parts to create a one-of-a-kind dinosaur in the Design-A-Dino area. Explore how dinosaurs lived and interacted through real life settings of various dinosaurs such as the Velociraptor and Dilophosaurus.

The Witte's permanent exhibit, focused on Texas dinosaurs, underwent an *Extreme Makeover*, giving visitors an opportunity to explore fossil evidence, examine dinosaur bones and learn about the latest paleontological discoveries.
