Witte Museum Presents Second Sunday Jazz Season

SAN ANTONIO—Jazz is back for the summer at the Witte Museum. Join us on **June 11** for **Ken Slavin**, a vocal "crooner" with straight-ahead jazz leanings. **Sunday Jazz** is **4-7 p.m.** on the **second Sunday of every month** through October 2006.

Bring lawn chairs or blankets and stake out a prime spot in the courtyard. Food and beverages are available for purchase from Catering by Beto's, whose menu includes empanadas, Latin specialties ... and beer and wine service. What a perfect way to spend a Sunday afternoon.

Sunday Jazz 2005 was a successful year with many great headliners. Featured artists showcased an array of jazz styles, including traditional be-bop, R&B and powerhouse vocals, bringing to life some old standards. And **Sunday Jazz 2006** promises to be just as entertaining, following the grand Mother's Day kickoff that featured Shelly Murray, Joan Carol, and Bette Butler.

On **July 9** **Henry Brun** hits the stage with Latin jazz and salsa fusion; **August 13** will bring **Regency**, a classic blue note-style jazz with nods to the masters of the be-bop and hard bop era; on **September 10** don't miss Austin based band **Blaze**, who come to the stage with jazz, indie and hip-hop sensibilities. And watch for the surprise announcement of a grand finale concert in October.

Sunday Jazz is free with paid museum admission. Museum admission is free to Witte members. Come early and enjoy the museum prior to the concert. Galleries close at 5 p.m.; however, the H-E-B Science Treehouse will remain open until 7 p.m. for the kids.
