## Tennessee Valley Authority Celebrates 35 years of Bluegrass Music at the Witte Museum

SAN ANTONIO—The award-winning **Tennessee Valley Authority (TVA)** has been churning out some of the best bluegrass music around for 35 years. Join the **Witte Museum** for a celebratory concert **6:30-8:30 p.m., Sunday, September 23, 2007** in the Prassel Auditorium. **This special performance features every musician who played with TVA since 1972.** Admission is \$8 for museum members, \$10 for adults and \$5 for students.

The Tennessee Valley Authority Bluegrass band was founded in 1972 by **Hank Harrison**, who held many TVA concerts at the Witte while working there, and his two brothers Jeff and Scott. They spent the next 35 years winning numerous prestigious awards and performing and touring with a long list of stars such as Johnny Gimble, Flaco Jimenez, Junior Brown, Michael Martin Murphy, Tony Rice, Kitty Wells and the Dixie Chicks, just to name a few.

Don't miss a chance to see **Hank Harrison** on mandolin and fiddle, **Jeff Large** on banjo, **Mary Ann Cornelius** on upright bass and **Keith Kimbell** on guitar for a hard-driving traditional performance with the ability to take non-bluegrass songs and deliver them in the bluegrass style.
