Helpful Hints for Parents

On your visit to the Witte Museum you may find these suggestions helpful in planning your day:

- Parking is located just south of the Witte Museum, off Tuleta Street on Avenue B or, in front of the Witte.
- Pack a lunch and have a picnic on the beautiful grounds of the Witte Museum.
- Brackenridge Park is located directly behind the Witte Museum and has many picnic areas as well as a playground.
- Restaurants close by include: Chipotle, IHOP, Picante Grill, Central Market, W.D. Deli, Sonic and McDonalds.
- While you are waiting for your child to compete explore some of our on going exhibitions; *Texas Wild*, *Dinosaurs*, *Ancient Texans: Rock Art and Lifeways Along the Lower Pecos*, and *Mummies: Unwrapping the Past*. Also the H-E-B Science Treehouse, River Alive and the Log Cabins and Onderdonk Studio.
- We also have several special temporary exhibitions now on view, including: *Colors on Clay: Pottery of San Antonio*; *Lonesome Dove: The Photographs of Bill Witliff*, and *Don Yena: Painting the South Texas Story*.
- Plus in our first floor gallery we are presenting *Circus Folk: Secrets Behind the Big Top*. This engaging interactive exhibit features media trunks, “secret” interactives, artifacts from the Herzberg collection and tells the stories of Life in a Traveling Village, The Circus Family, Getting Physical, and Rules of the Ring, as well as circus life in Clown Alley, the Circus Family Village Model and the Circus Theater. (a \$3 additional admission fee applies.)
